CITY COUNCIL MEETING
TUESDAY, JANUARY 13, 2026

Minutes of the City of Berryville, January 13, 2026, City Council Meeting,

Members present: Mayor Dennis Selby, Mayor Pro Tem Bobbie Evans, Councilwoman Brenda Pulis, Councilman Clinton Lax, Councilman Gene Fagelson and Councilman Edward Bogue.

Mayor Selby called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. with an invocation given by Mayor Pro Tem Evans and a salute to the flag.

Citizens' Comments: None.

Item #3: Water & Field Operations: Ruben Servin to present a report on the status of the city's water and field operations for the past month.

Water Supervisor Servin gave the water report and informed everyone they were still waiting on materials from Jason with Wanda Drilling to finish the work at water well six.

Item # 4: Volunteer Fire Department: Chief Ogg to present the report on the Volunteer Fire Department previous month's activities.

Fire Chief Ogg read the VFD report and informed everyone that he and Mayor Selby had attended a seminar in Greenville, Texas.

Item #5: Discuss and take-action on the City's Financial Reports for the month of December 2025.

Councilwoman Pulis made a motion to approve financials as presented. Mayor Pro Tem Evans seconded the motion. Questions. None. Vote. All were in favor.

Item #6: Discuss and take action on December City Council minutes.

Councilwoman Pulis made a motion to accept minutes as presented. Mayor Pro Tem Evans seconded the motion. Questions. None. Vote. All were in favor.

Item #7: Discuss and take action on separation of the BVFD Accounts from the City to the Fire Department. Name authorized users to Austin Bank.

Councilman Fagelson made a motion to purchase a second version of quickbooks to be purchased by the VFD, separate VFD account from the city and assign new signature cards for the account with

names to include Dennis Selby, Wanda Hewlett, and James Ogg. Mayor Pro Tem Evans seconded the motion. All were in favor.

Item #8: Discuss and take action on transferring monthly donations from water billing to BVFD accounts.

Mayor Pro Tem Evans made a motion to write a check to transfer BVFD funds. Councilwoman Pulis seconded the motion. Questions. None. All were in favor.

Item #9: Update on Ordinance Committee status.

Councilwoman Pulis passed out update to the Council showing what Ordinances had been reviewed and not reviewed yet. Councilwoman Pulis stated the next committee meeting would be January 23, 2026.

Item #10: Discuss and take action on notification of Rates Increase for Live Oak trash pickup as per contract.

Mayor Selby and Council had a brief discussion. Mayor stated this has been an ongoing topic and rates haven't been increased in years. Councilwoman Pulis made a motion to increase the rates to \$25.50 per month for basic trash pickup. Mayor Pro Tem Evans seconded the motion. Questions. None. Vote. Four were in favor, (Mayor Pro Tem Evans, Councilwoman Pulis, Councilman Lax and Councilman Bogue). One opposed (Councilman Fagelson).

Item #11: Discuss and take action on date for City Council Workshop for discussion of goals for 2026. Agenda for workshop to be proposed.

Mayor Selby and Council discussed dates briefly. Councilwoman Pulis made a motion for council workshop to be held February 18, 2026, at 10:30 a.m. to discuss budget, ordinances, and equipment. Councilman Lax seconded the motion. All were in favor.

Item #12: Mayor's Report

Mayor Selby read his monthly report with highlights of the month and informed everyone he would be having knee surgery on January 20, 2026.

Item # 13: Adjourn.

All items discussed Councilman Fagelson made a motion to adjourn. Councilwoman Pulis seconded the motion. Vote. All were in favor. Meeting was adjourned at 7:40 p.m.
