CITY COUNCIL MEETING
TUESDAY, MARCH 10, 2026

Minutes of the City of Berryville, March 10, 2026, City Council Meeting,

Members present: Mayor Dennis Selby, Mayor Pro Tem Bobbie Evans, Councilwoman Brenda Pulis, Councilman Clinton Lax, Councilman Gene Fagelson and Councilman Edward Bogue.

Mayor Selby called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. with an invocation and a salute to the flags.

Citizens' Comments: None.

Item #3: Water & Field Operations: Ruben Servin to present a report on the status of the city's water and field operations for the past month.

Water Supervisor, Servin read the water report and informed everyone that water well six was back on line. Servin also thanked the Mayor & Council for the Gradall excavator. Councilman Fagelson asked if water well seven was scheduled for maintenance yet. Servin stated no.

Item # 4: Volunteer Fire Department: Chief Ogg to present the report on the Volunteer Fire Department previous month's activities.

Fire Chief Ogg read the VFD report and informed everyone that Henderson County wasn't under a burn ban. Chief Ogg thanked the City stating the VFD had survived a year after having to rebuild and stated State Farm had donated 5 laptops for training. Councilman Fagelson asked for the status on the bumper truck. Chief Ogg stated it was still being built.

Item #5: Discuss and take-action on the City's Financial Reports for the month of February 2026.

Councilman Fagelson made a motion to accept financials as presented. Councilwoman Pulis seconded the motion. Questions. None. Vote. All were in favor.

Item #6: Discuss and take action on February City Council minutes.

Mayor Pro Tem Evans made a motion to accept all minutes February 10th, February 17th and March 3rd as presented. Councilman Lax seconded the motion. Questions. None. Vote. All were in favor.

Item #7: Discuss and take action on the March 3rd, Special Meeting Minutes concerning new Water Rates.

Mayor Selby stated this was taken care of with item # 6.

Item #8: Consider and take action: A). Accepting the Certificate of Unopposed Candidates presented and the Order of Cancellation cancelling the Election for May 2, 2026, to elect City Council places 1, 3 and 4 due to all candidates being unopposed.

Councilwoman Pulis made a motion to accept the certificate of unopposed candidates and cancel the election for May 2, 2026. Mayor Pro Tem Evans seconded the motion. Questions. None. Vote. All were in favor.

Item #9: Committee Update for Reds Landing.

Councilman Lax gave an update on Reds Landing stating Ruben, Dave and Henry had been cleaning up at Reds Landing, he stated he had gotten locks and keys for the gate, spent \$730.00 on supplies for the dock, Dave and Ruben will fix the fence and gate. Mayor Selby stated he was working on applications and a sign was being made. Councilwoman Pulis asked if Reds Landing would be ready by the 4th of July maybe some activities could be held there. Mayor Selby stated he didn't see a reason why it wouldn't.
