

Mayor's Report

CC Meeting June 9, 2026

1. Water's Edge development. 217 lots, 89 boat slips. They have asked for a Memorandum of Understanding. They want to put up \$1,000,000 for Berryville to provide water services. Are willing to bring the development into the city limits of Berryville.
2. Need to keep abreast of Coffee City VFD looking to be annexed into District 6 ESD.
3. New payment options for water bills. Setup will be completed this week. Updated instructions will be on website.
4. Document management system. Updating quote. Looking to implement in new fiscal year.
5. Work with new auditor to take on audits for current and past fiscal year.
6. Asked auditor about Charitable Donations for BVFD. He indicated that 501c designation is not necessary since the city has that basically by default. Need to further define and place on website and communicate to our community.
7. Review Medical Insurance coverage. Have renewal from BCBSTX. City covers employee alone. Any additional persons, employee cover. First 2 children covered separately. No other bids received. Need to start review earlier next year.\
8. Trinidad, TX having severe water issues and has caused discourse between city council and city administration. Several federal lawsuits have been filed against the city.
9. Nuisance ordinances, junk vehicles etc. Utilize a standard notice form that identifies the violations, property owner, remediation action and consequences. Use tracking spreadsheets
10. Recent meetings - May 20-22 TML Bastrop. Small Cities Conference and Small Cities Advisory Council
11. We have initiated the setup of texting to the Mayor at his office number. We will be testing over the next few weeks. We will add that access to his signature on emails and his page on the website.
